

SPRING 2023 INTERFAITH DISCUSSION GUIDE RAMADAN + PASSOVER + EASTER

Overview

- In the spring of 2023, for the second time in more than three decades, followers of several faiths will observe religious holidays over the same month.
- From March 22 to April 21, this includes the celebrations of Spring Solstice, Ramadan, Passover, Mahavir Jayanti, Theravada New Year, Easter, Vaisakhi and Ridván.
- This means that Muslims, Jews, Christians, Baha'is, Sikhs, Hindus, Buddhists, Pagans and others will all be practicing their significant religious and cultural traditions around the same time.
- This convergence is an important opportunity to remind our employees, patients, residents and communities of our interconnectedness.
- It also offers a chance to recommit to our values of Community and Family, celebrating the diverse make-up of the populations we serve and serve alongside.

Discussion Questions

Consider including an interfaith conversation as part of an upcoming team meeting, or in a one-on-one conversation with a team member.

From the outset remind all participants to <u>practice the SAFE Universal Relationship Skills</u> – especially remembering to listen with empathy and the intent to understand.

- What values and ideals are important to you, whether through the lens of an ethical, faith, spiritual, or cultural tradition?
 - Where do you find the opportunity to live out those values in your daily work with Sanford/GSS?
- Are you connected to a community that will be observing a religious, cultural, Indigenous or spiritual holiday during this spring period? If so...
 - o What is a favorite aspect of that tradition for you?
 - What does it mean to you to be celebrating your meaningful tradition alongside other communities who are celebrating their own?
- Have you ever engaged in a religious or cultural observance outside of your own tradition?
 - o If so, what was that experience like?
 - o What did you learn?
